Apart from the colours and the music, this is mainly due to the (predominantly female) fans themselves – young people dancing barefoot, celebrating with old and new friends and are willing to embrace a different culture. This works even without a spiritual reference. "Even a representative of the Indian embassy visited our Holi Festival Of Colours with his family and was overwhelmed", says Maxim Derenko. "Just as in India, our goal is to celebrate together in a peaceful and joyous atmosphere. Pillared by the cultural diversity, the fun and mutual respect."

With this extraordinary approach the Holi Festival Of Colours sets itself apart from the rest of the European festival scene. The music plays an integral role, but only in combination with the overwhelming rush of colours and the unique audience the Festival Of Colours becomes a true festival for the senses.
